		<p>Askrigg 4.3% Yorkshire Dales</p> <p>Askrigg Ale is a golden ale brewed in Askrigg in the heart of the Yorkshire Dales. This award-winning ale has a clean hoppy finish from the Amarillo hops and good underlying sharpness. Suitable for vegans.</p>
		<p>Avalanche 4.5% Fyne</p> <p>Thirst-Quenching Pale Bold and bracing like the Glen Fyne hills on a winter's morning, Avalanche is the quintessential, refreshing pale ale showcasing Cascade and Liberty hops.</p>
		<p>Bad to the Bone 3.8% Oscars</p> <p>A Golden IPA, hop blasted with Eldorado, Mosaic & Motueka to give tropical flavours of passion fruit, mango and lime.</p>
		<p>Blind Jack 3.7% Roosters</p> <p>Blind Jack is an amber ale brewed with the addition of Rye malt and a blend of American hops to create a quaffable beer with citrus fruit aromas and a light, spicy finish.</p>
		<p>Bread & Butter 3.9% Vocation</p> <p>A satisfying reward that's always worth the hard work. With layers of US hops combined with British malts, our fresh and easy-drinking dry-hopped pale is a solid staple that delivers every time. Proof that the simple things in life are often the best. Refreshing flavours and aromas of lychees, pine, citrus and peach. Finished off with a smooth, rounded bitterness. Suitable for vegans</p>
		<p>Brew York, Brew York 4.9% Brew York</p> <p>So good they named it twice - and hopped it thrice! An enticing aroma to tantalise and tempt the taste buds, with a beautifully tropical flavour that keeps you craving more. Expect blackcurrant, expect grapefruit and expect an urge to start spreading the brews! Suitable for vegans</p>
		<p>Bumble 4.0% - Bowland</p> <p>Blond ale lightly hopped with double addition of honey. The bees travel throughout the Forest of Bowland, pollinating many flowers, nuts, and vegetables as they go. Flavours from each come back with the bee and make their way into the honey creating a unique flavour profile for their beer. SIBA Gold Winner 2022.</p>

		<p>Bunny Hop 3.4% - Purity</p> <p>Hazy Pale. Bunny Hop is an extra hopped pale ale brewed with Maris Otter, Lager Malt, Cara Pils and Wheat Malts. Then generously hopped with Pilgrim, Eureka, El Dorado and Chinook. Bunny Hop is a bold beer, which perfectly balances its low abv of 3.5%, pale malts and powerful hops. Suitable for vegans and gluten free.</p>
		<p>Calmer Chameleon 4.1% Brew York</p> <p>The green dream of super juicy and resinous hops Columbus, Mosaic, Simcoe and Citra uniting in a super smashable pale ale. Suitable for vegans</p>
		<p>Crafty Mild 3.6% Kirby Lonsdale</p> <p>Their modern incarnation of the traditional mild, brewed with rich, dark malts and delicately hopped for a very moreish beer.</p>
		<p>Creeper 4.0% Roosters</p> <p>Brewed with the addition of freshly peeled cucumbers, Creeper is a light, crisp and easy-drinking, pale ale. Delicate, refreshing and outrageously drinkable, it's the ideal accompaniment to a sunny Spring day!</p>
		<p>Heart & Soul 4.4% Vocation</p> <p>Created from the heart and brewed with a double dose of devotion, this full-bodied fruity beer has all the hoppy goodness of an IPA, but with a seriously sessionable strength. Expect a fruit salad flavour with bold notes of passionfruit, grapefruit, gooseberry, pineapple and mango. Suitable for vegans and gluten free</p>
		<p>Heartland 3.9% Pennine</p> <p>Dark copper coloured ale with a toffee, malted caramel smell and a rich smooth moreish flavour.</p>
		<p>Imperial Yorkshire Stout 8.5% Black Sheep</p> <p>Stand out from the herd with this bold and punchy Imperial Stout. Not for the faint hearted, <u>but must surely be on your bucket list.</u> Only brewed once a year in small quantities, this limited edition stout beer is strong, complex, and one to savour or share. A voluminous blend of dark malts builds the base of this stout, full of sugars</p>

		<p>for our house yeast to chew on, and bringing the ABV up to a hefty 8.5%. Packed with flavours of dark roasted coffee, chocolate and red fruit, this is the ultimate winter warmer.</p>
		<p>King Neptune 4.3% Bosuns</p> <p>A session IPA that's light golden in colour, has a fruity nose and subtle bursts of citrus and grapefruit flavours – the ultimate booty! Shiver me timbers, it's good.</p>
		<p>Loki's Mischief 4.0% Rudgate</p> <p>Fresh and pale with blackcurrant, lemongrass and hints of marjoram. Named after the shape shifting Norse god of Mischief... This intriguing ale suggests a playful and mischievous character...??</p>
		<p>Magus 3.8% Durham</p> <p>Their best seller – the perfect session pale ale. Pale malts provide a base for a complex blend of UK, Czech and US hops. Zingy lemon, subtle grapefruit bitterness, tropical fruit notes with a hint of floral hop. A crisp and spicy black pepper finish. Suitable for vegans and gluten free. In European law, beer which is under 20 ppm can be described as gluten free. Magus has under 10 ppm gluten.</p>
		<p>Millie George 4.0% Pennine</p> <p>Named after their daughter Millie George, a definite blonde with attitude! A refreshing ale with a mellow bitterness. Brewed using English Maris Otter barley and flavoured with a fruity hop. A real thirst quencher.</p>
		<p>Sharp Pinz 4.0% Moorhouses</p> <p>The lemon and lime overtones combine with palette cleansing freshness and a citrus aroma for a refreshing taste.</p>
		<p>Springtime 3.8% Yorkshire Dales</p> <p>Brewed with Mandarina Bavaria and Huell Melon hops, so expect tropical fruity and sweet with notes of citrus and tangerine and with an aromas of honeydew melon and strawberry.</p>

		<p>Tempest 5.6% Bosuns</p> <p>Full Bodied IPA - This American IPA is light gold in colour and brewed using fine American hops. Despite its fruity nose and bursts of citrus and grapefruit flavours, it doesn't cure scurvy, unfortunately.</p>
		<p>Triple Hop 3.9% Rudgate</p> <p>Balanced malt and hop flavours with zesty, fruity hop aromas.</p>
		<p>White Gold 4.0 Durham</p> <p>Perfectly balanced session blonde ale. Dry hopped with US Cascade for a spicy citrus and floral hop aroma. The body is fruity with sweet orange notes and a gentle grapefruit bitterness.</p>
		<p>White Wolf 3.8% Deeply Dale</p> <p>Brewed using Styrian Wolf hops which give the characteristics of Mango, Passionfruit and Lemongrass. The beer is an extra pale and at 3.8% ABV makes a really good session type ale.</p>
		<p>Witches Cauldron 4.2 Moorhouse's</p> <p>An amber coloured ale. Rich in malt, with a fruity body and a strong hop aftertaste. Brewed with Progress, Willamette and using Crystal, Maris Otter, Pale Ale, Wheat malts.</p>
