

Thorner Beer Festival 2023 – The Beers

		<p>A Little Faith 4.0% - Northern monk</p> <p>Hazy Pale Ale. All the juice, citrus and tropical flavour of Faith, but even more of a session beer at a lower ABV of 4%. Normally only available in keg, so definitely one to try. Vegan Friendly.</p>
		<p>Asgard's Legend 4.2% - Rudgate, Rudgate</p> <p>Fresh, light, balanced golden ale with floral and grapefruit aroma.</p>
		<p>Bantam Best 4.0% - Ainsty</p> <p>Their Classic Premium Bitter, using only British hops & malts. An Amber Ale with subtle Pear fruit and floral aromas, slightly sweet with a crisp bitter finish.</p>
		<p>Blueberry Classic Bitter 5.0% - Coach House</p> <p>A wonderful straw coloured beer with a light hoppy aroma and a distinct blueberry aftertaste. A multi award winner across the country. 2015 – Gold SIBA NW Speciality Small Pack 2015 – Silver SIBA NW Overall Small Pack 2015 – Silver SIBA NW Speciality Cask</p>
		<p>Brewers Gold – 3.8% Pictish</p> <p>A refreshing trist quencing pale golden session beer. Malty undertones and a powerful spicy hop aroma combine to produce a dangerously moreish beer.</p>
		<p>Café Amsterdam 3.9% - Yorkshire Dales Brewing Co., Askrigg</p> <p>A super hoppy American Pale Ale with simcoe, citra and dry hopped with mosaic.</p>
		<p>Capability Brown 4.0% - Roosters</p> <p>A classic best bitter, deep amber in colour and displaying classic English hedgerow hop characteristics harnessed from a blend of Challenger, Fuggles and Whitbread Goldings Variety hops.</p>
		<p>Cool Citra 4.4% - Ainsty</p> <p>A West Coast American Pale, Single Hopped and then double dry-hopped with the classic Citra Hop to give an intense Grapefruit & Citrus aroma, Clean, Crisp & very refreshing!</p>

		<p>Fair Jenny's Jig Extra Pale 4.4% - Ayr</p> <p>Brewed with El Dorado Hops from the Yakima Valley in Washington and Low Colour Maris Otter and Wheat Malts. Tropical and stone fruit flavours with a hint of watermelon and a long lemon hoppy dancing finish.</p>
		<p>HPA – 4.0% Wye Valley</p> <p>HPA is an easy-going real ale that brings people together (their words!). Using locally grown Target and Celeia hops hang with Maris Otter pale malt gives this understated brew its pale straw colour, citrus hop aroma and a balanced bitter finish.</p>
		<p>IPA 4.2% - Lancaster</p> <p>A well-hopped IPA with a dry, crisp finish. Brewed with Warrior hops.</p>
		<p>Jaguar 4.5% - Kelburn</p> <p>A golden, full bodied ale with undertones of grapefruit and a long lasting citrus, hoppy aftertaste. This beer has bite!.</p>
		<p>Mad King Sweeny 4.6% - Strange Times</p> <p>Inspired by the turbulent life of Buile Suibhne, this Irish red ale brewed with rye and oats, is smooth and balanced enough to calm the mad king himself.</p>
		<p>Monumental 4.5% - Kirby Lonsdale</p> <p>A wonderfully golden ale brewed with extra pale malt, blended with English and Slovenian Golding Hops for a distinct floral aroma and mouth feel.</p>
		<p>Nidd Mild 3.7% - Harrogate</p> <p>A twist on a traditional mild - made with a blend of amber, brown, pale chocolate and Crystal rye malt for a deep dark colour and complex malt flavour. Notes of freshly roasted coffee, tobacco and bourbon whiskey</p>
		<p>Pendle witches brew 5.1% - Moorhouses</p> <p>A bold, malty amber beer with spice fruit notes and crisp fruity aftertaste.</p>

		<p>Plum Porter 4.8% - Harrogate</p> <p>Sweet plums mixed with chocolate malt to create a delicious, earthy porter.</p>
		<p>Raspberry Pale 4.7% - Titanic</p> <p>This wonderfully fruity wheat beer is refreshingly and light. Allergen Advice: this beer contains barley & wheat.</p>
		<p>Rose Petal 4.8% - Ossett</p> <p>Showcasing the new UK-grown hop variety Mystic™ from the Charles Faram Hop Development Programme, this is a hazy, unfiltered IPA with low bitterness and intense floral hop aromas. Mystic™ are added during the brewing process both as a late hop and in the whirlpool, and then again as a double dry hop during fermentation to give aromas of orange, blueberry and spice. The floral and spicy characteristics are further augmented by the addition of rose petals, cardamon and coriander. Vegan friendly.</p>
		<p>Silver King 4.3% - Ossett</p> <p>One of the original Ossett core beers from 1998 and SIBA national champion. This regal beer continues to be a timeless classic. A simple combination of UK grown pale malt and American Cascade and Chinook hops result in a crisp, dry and refreshing pale ale with aromas of citrus fruit and balanced bitterness. This beer is also gluten free.</p>
		<p>Swail Trail Pale 3.8%- Yorkshire Dales Brewing Co</p> <p>Blonde with Ekuanot hops. With Ekuanot expect fruity aromatics such as lemon, lime, pithy orange, tropical fruit, berry, papaya, and sometimes apple. Along with these there may be more herbal notes, like sage and eucalyptus. Possibly even a background note of hay and cedar may also be noted.</p>
		<p>Thousand Yard Stare 5.4% - Roosters</p> <p>A light, yet full-flavoured and hazy pale ale with an intense tropical fruit nose. Citrus, stone fruit and resinous notes dance around the palate, giving way to a juicy and mouth-watering finish. Gluten free/ Unfiltered / Unfiltered</p>
		<p>Whernside Pale Ale 4.2% - Three Peaks</p> <p>A classic easy drinking pale ale. This light amber coloured ale uses Maris Otter malt & two types of hops which are added late in the boil to bring a wonderful hoppy finish to the taste.</p>

		<p>York Chocolate Stout 5.0% - Rudgate, Rudgate</p> <p>A deep rich and satisfying premium stout with complex balanced flavours and a warm subtle chocolate finish.</p>
		<p>Yorkshire Farmer 4.0% - Bradfield</p> <p>A gold coloured beer light on the palate with a smooth bitter finish.</p>
